Symptom (public)

Do I have to attach certified copies of my documents to the application form?

Problem (public)

I want to apply for a Master's degree programme. Do I have to hand in certified copies or is an application with uncertified copies possible?

Solution (public)

Foreign certificates must be handed in as officially certified copies with an officially certified translation. If your documents do not fulfil the requirements or if important certificates are missing, your application will not be processed. Documents don't have to be translated if they are issued in German, English or French.

Certificates that were obtained at German educational institutions, don't need to be certified and can be submitted as simple/uncertified copies.
