A proxy object is the basis for provisioning a target system. It is generated from information found in the Resource Descriptors, Resource Descriptor Extensions and the Resources themselves. The object itself is redundant. It can be provisioned into the target system using simple IDM drivers which do not need the Meta Directory Logic.
